Tiny Tots at the May pole Gala

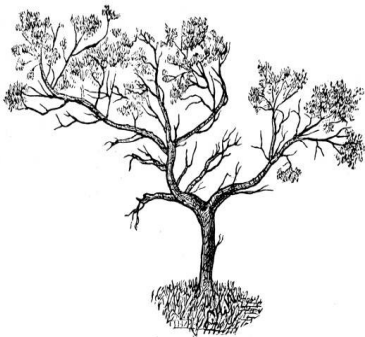
